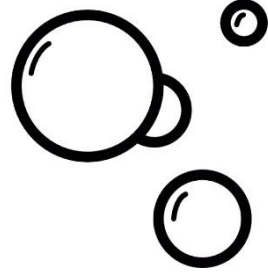


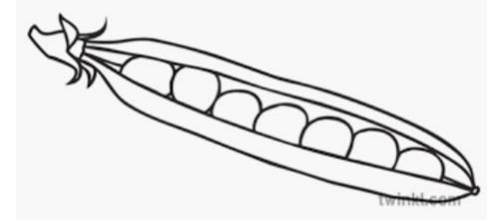
Bubbles and pods: organised groups of children and adults

Reception to Y8 will be organised in class bubbles. This means that the children will stay in their class group and have no contact with children from other classes.



Y9 will remain in a class bubble for everything except for their MFL, art and music lessons. In these lessons they will be socially distanced from those in the other class bubble.

Y10 and Y11 will be in year group pods. The children will only have contact with other children within their year group. This will enable us to teach GCSE options subjects and use flexible groupings.



Y12 and Y13 will be grouped together to form one sixth form pod. Where subjects are taught across institutions this will happen in a socially distanced manner or via remote learning e.g. zoom.

Due to the nature and size of the bubbles and pods, and the nature and size of some of our teaching spaces we will need to amend the curriculum slightly e.g. Y6-9 will not be doing Food Technology.

Specialist teaching spaces e.g. science labs will be used on rotation and cleaned between bubbles / pods.
