Maths - Functional Skills

The main focus is on using number in everyday life and getting a maths qualification. You will be able to develop your maths skills and how to apply them in everyday situations. This will help you study at a higher level, get a job or improve your job level.

By the end of the course, you will be able to (it depends on level)...

- Calculate with money, length, weight, capacity and time (fractions, decimals and percentages)
- Compare and evaluate cost and time
- Describe shapes, and their properties, understand and draw information to scale
- Read, understand and present information in tables, lists, graphs and charts

...in everyday situations such as work, shopping, health, education, leisure (topics depend on level, interest and need)

In the class you will...

- Work in small groups, pairs, and individually
- Take part in problem solving tasks
- Practise maths skills in everyday situations
- Do quizzes and games

Pre-course requirement: Reading skills of at least Entry 2 English
